Narcan (Naloxone) is an opioid antagonist. It dislodges opioid molecules from the brain's receptors and blocks them from binding again. This effect can quickly restore a person's breathing to normal if that person's breathing has slowed down or stopped because of an opioid overdose. Naloxone WILL NOT improve breathing in people who have overdosed on other substances (such as alcohol) or for other reasons (such as asthma).
